SAMPLE FRESH SEAFOOD



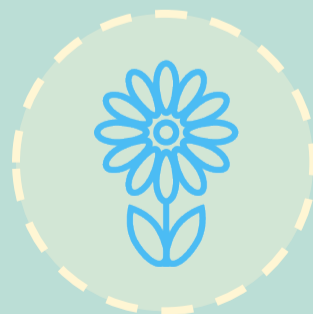
